

Director's Notes

Hairspray was originally a 1988 film written and directed by John Waters, whose previous films were noted both for pushing the boundaries of censorship and film ratings as well as addressing social and cultural issues. In 2002, it was created into a Broadway musical that ran for over 2,500 performances and closed on January 4, 2009. **Hairspray** won eight Tony Awards, and was then turned into a musical film in 2007, starring John Travolta. And now, we have **Hairspray Live!** Clearly, this is a story worth retelling again and again.

A bit of history...the television show that inspired the plot of **Hairspray**, *The Buddy Deane Show*, aired until 1964, when it was shut down for refusing to integrate. The peaceful protests and eventual integration of the television network in **Hairspray** mirror the sit-in rallies, protests, and eventual change of perspective led by Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

Here we are in 2016, with news headlines of racial discrimination, inequality, and crooked politics. Sounds familiar, doesn't it? If you scratch at the surface of **Hairspray** just a bit, go past the catchy songs and amazing dance numbers, this story is incredibly relevant today. Right here, right now. This story has integrity and strength of spirit written all over it. Our unlikely hero, Tracy Turnblad pulls back the veil of unsavory behavior, while singing and dancing her way into all of our hearts.

I think the world needs more Tracy Turnblads as we continue to break down prejudice of all kinds, systemic privilege, and the barriers created by stereotypes. Tracy sees people as individuals and truly believes in a better world. Some people call that naïveté; I call it hope – and speaking of that, it is my sincere hope that you enjoy Cupcake Theatre's production of **Hairspray!**
