

Even the support of my running club, Pasadena Pacers, has expressed their enthusiasm and support and were the first to purchase advance tickets. As the African proverb says, "Many hands make light work".

I would like to thank Michael for asking me to take on this dream project, Ben and Liz for the amazing set, Kenji for his sound design, Kevin for making everyone look so good under the lights, Jarek for his sweet dance moves, Nick for making the music and singing in this production so freaking strong and powerful, the cast for busting their butts and pushing themselves to be better with every rehearsal, Susannah for being my companion in this process and doing everything (I mean everything) that needed to get taken care of, and the audience for showing up and loving live theater.
